

The Thrace Faculty of Law

Geographically extending throughout the region of Thrace, Democritus University is now the largest regional University in Greece, consisting of 8 Schools, 20 Departments and an active student population exceeding 30.000 (undergraduate, postgraduate students and PhD candidates).

The Faculty of Law, the founding academic unit of the University, has been in operation since 1974. It offers high quality teaching and research by its academic staff and is supported by high standards infrastructure.

The Faculty of Law, developed in line with European academic standards, has gained international renown which enables it to respond to the expectation of academic excellence with great success.

The Thrace Law Faculty has been participating in the mobility programmes of the EU since 1986 and has developed a wide network of collaborations with European Universities.



Why Erasmus at the Thrace Faculty of Law?

Erasmus studies at the Thrace Law Faculty is a choice for a number of reasons:

The Faculty offers an up-to-date and wide-ranging curriculum, offering the Erasmus incoming students courses taught in English on 28 subjects, divided into two semesters.



The University provides Erasmus students with low-cost accommodation and meals at the University hostels

Prior to their arrival, Erasmus entrants are supported by the International Relations Office, while Student Associations, especially ESN-DUTH, and former Erasmus participants assist new students providing them with information concerning their studies and life in the city.



Academic Calendar

The academic year starts on 1st September and ends on 31st August of the next year. It is divided into two semesters and includes three examination periods of one month each: in February, June and September (resit exams).

Each semester lasts thirteen weeks. Lectures of the winter semester start within the second week of October and end the second fortnight of January. Lectures of the spring semester start within the second fortnight of February and end the last week of May.





Official holidays

- · 28th October: National Day
- 17th of November: Polytechnion Anniversary
- 25th and 26th December: Christmas Holiday
- 1st and 2nd January: New Year Holiday
- 30th January: Three Patrons of Education Day
- Shrove Monday: The day after the Carnival Sunday (7 weeks before Orthodox Easter)
- Easter Sunday and Monday: Easter Holiday
- 25th of March: National Day
- 1st May: Labour Day
- 14th May: Local Holiday (liberation anniversary of Komotini)
- Pentecost Monday (Holly Spirit's Day): Fifty days after Easter Sunday

Educational Holidays

- Christmas/New year Holiday: Two weeks
- Friday before the Carnival Sunday
- Orthodox Easter Holiday: Two weeks
- Summer holidays: July, August
